LESSON 21

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM

What is Baptism? Baptism is not just plain water, but it is the water included in God's command and combined with God's word.

Which is that word of God? Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Matthew: Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. (Matt. 28:19)

LESSON 22

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

What benefit does Baptism give? It works forgiveness of sins, rescues from death and the devil, and gives eternal salvation to all who believe this, as the words and promises of God declare.

LESSON 23

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

Which are these words and promises of God? Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Mark: Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. (Mark 16:16)

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

How can water do such great things? Certainly not just water, but the Word of God in and with the water does these things, along with the faith which trusts this Word of God in the water. For without God's Word the water is plain water and not Baptism.

LESSON 25

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

But with the Word of God it is a Baptism, that is a life-giving water, rich in grace, and a washing of the new birth in the Holy Spirit, as St. Paul says in Titus chapter three.

LESSON 26

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior,

LESSON 27

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

so that, having been justified by His grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life. This is a trustworthy saying. (Titus 3:5b-8a)

LESSON 28

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

What does such baptizing with water indicate? It indicates that the Old Adam in us should by daily contrition and repentance be drowned and die with all sins and evil desires, and that a new man should daily emerge and arise to live before God in righteousness and purity forever.

LESSON 29

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

Where is this written? St. Paul writes in Romans chapter six: We are therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (Romans 6:4)

(HOLY BAPTISM CONTINUED --)

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. (Psalm 51:10)

I rejoiced with those who said to me, "Let us go to the house of the Lord." (Psalm 122:1)

The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work. (1 John 3:8b)

LESSON 31

It is by grace you have been saved, through faith----and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God. (Ephesians 2:8)

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life." (John 14:6)

My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. (John 15:12)

LESSON 32

Be completely humble and gentle: be patient, bearing with one another in love...Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. (Ephesians 4:2, 32)

(Jesus) Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness. (1 Peter 2:24)

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

LESSON 33

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us. (Ephesians 4:32—5:2)

I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes. (Romans 1:16)
