# OUR CLASS BEHAVIOR PLAN

I believe that all children are capable of behaving well in the classroom. That being said, here is our behavior plan.

Our class has 6 rules and we will review them every day:

1. Stay Safe
2. Take Turns
3. Practice Responsibility
4. Act Respectfully
5. Uplift Everyone
6. Love Each Other

If your child is spoken to about a rule we will fill out one of the forms shown above. This just means we talked about it and you probably should too. The natural consequence of this is that they had to miss some recess, center time, or computer time to talk to me. Any students who cannot act appropriately using this plan will be placed on an individual behavior plan that works for them and I will call or talk with you in person about this. Please sign any forms sent home and return it the next day.

In addition, on the pink homework sheet you will see that your child has a certain color each day.

Green – I was right on track and did what I was told.

Yellow or Red - I had warnings about my behavior and lost a classroom privilege. (Minutes of recess, Center time etc.)

This system will be taught to your children in class AND there will be supports in place to ensure your child is reporting the correct color. You will be surprised at how capable and honest your children will be using this system. Please let me know if you have any any questions!
